Notes:

- 1. New students (including transfer students and students coming through the recommendation/screening process) may ask to defer their enrollment in the event of serious illness that requires long-term recuperation or other special circumstances (including pregnancy, childbirth, or the need to take care of children under three years of age) that prevent them from beginning their study when the semester starts. They must produce medical and other related proof by a regional or a higher-level hospital under the Department of Health's classification when submitting an enrollment deferment application to the Office of Academic Affairs. They may defer their enrollment after the applications are approved.
- 2. Enrollment deferment may last for only one year. However, if during the deferment the student is drafted into military service, he may produce proof of military service and ask to extend the deferment. Upon completion of military service, the student may produce proof of discharge from the military and ask to resume his enrollment.
- 3. The University shall announce the registration process on August.
